COVID-19 RELATED ADVISORY

The Indian community in Sudan is hereby informed that Government of India has now extended the lockdown by two weeks. The suspension of commercial flights has also been extended till 17th May, 2020. But significant relaxations have been given so as to ease the situation for the people. Government has begun ferrying the stranded workers to their home states and it is learnt that it is considering proposals for evacuating Indians stranded abroad as well.

Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi has been kept duly informed of the COVID situation here in Sudan, concerns and sentiments of the compatriots and their earnest request for evacuation in view of the rising number of positive cases of COVID-19 and inadequate testing/treatment facilities for COVID-19.

The Embassy will be sharing an update as soon as received from the Ministry of External Affairs. In the meantime, all are requested to be calm, not to panic, follow preventive measures & guidelines, and stay indoors.
