Advisory on Covid-19 related Evacuation Facilitation

The Embassy is happy to inform all the stranded and other Indian nationals that Sudanese authorities are organising chartered flights of 'Badr Airlines' to bring back Sudanese nationals stranded in different cities of India on payment basis. Their schedule is likely to be as under:

Date	Route
Tuesday 30/06/2020	Khartoum - Chennai - Khartoum
Wednesday 01/07/2020	Khartoum - Delhi - Khartoum
Thursday 02/07/2020	Khartoum - Hyderabad - Khartoum
Friday 03/07/2020	Khartoum - Bangalore - Khartoum

'Badr Airlines' has offered to evacuate interested Indian nationals from Khartoum to the above destinations in India @ USD 510/- per person. Since the first flight from Khartoum to Chennai is tentatively scheduled to depart Khartoum on 29 June, the fellow Indians interested in evacuating, particularly the people from the states of Tamil Nadu, Kerala, and Puducherry, may wish to utilise this flight for going back. And people from the other states may use the other destinations as above and convenient to them.
